The Heart of Georgia Developmental Disabilities Ministries (DDM) was organized in 2004 in response to the need for additional homes for adults with developmental disabilities here in the Central Georgia area.

According to the organization, a DDM home is a long-term care facility that provides individualized assistance for residents to develop their self-help skills all while in a Christian family setting. The capacity of each home will be 4 to 6 residents, plus two live-in house parents and a weekend relief person.

Their current goal is to accumulate funds for the construction and furnishings for at least two homes. MidSouth VP of Development, DeAnn Dent, presented a donation to the Heart of Georgia DDM Chairman, Hulda Cook, in an effort to help them in their ongoing efforts.
