M. Studdard Receives Scholarship

Georgia Federal Credit Union (GFCU) has announced the winners for its 2010 scholarship program, and Megan Ann Studdard a senior at Jasper County High School is one of the local scholarship recipients.

Some \$10,000 will be awarded to 11 students through the GFCU Vernon E. Carne Scholarship Fund, created in honor of the Credit Union's founder. This is the 16th year GFCU has given the scholarship awards.

Selection was based on academic accomplishments, leadership and participation in both school and community activities and an essay on how the credit union philosophy of 'people helping people' helps communities.

This year's essay competition drew entries from 43 different high schools and the top winner was Shelley Anne Evans of Fayetteville, who
