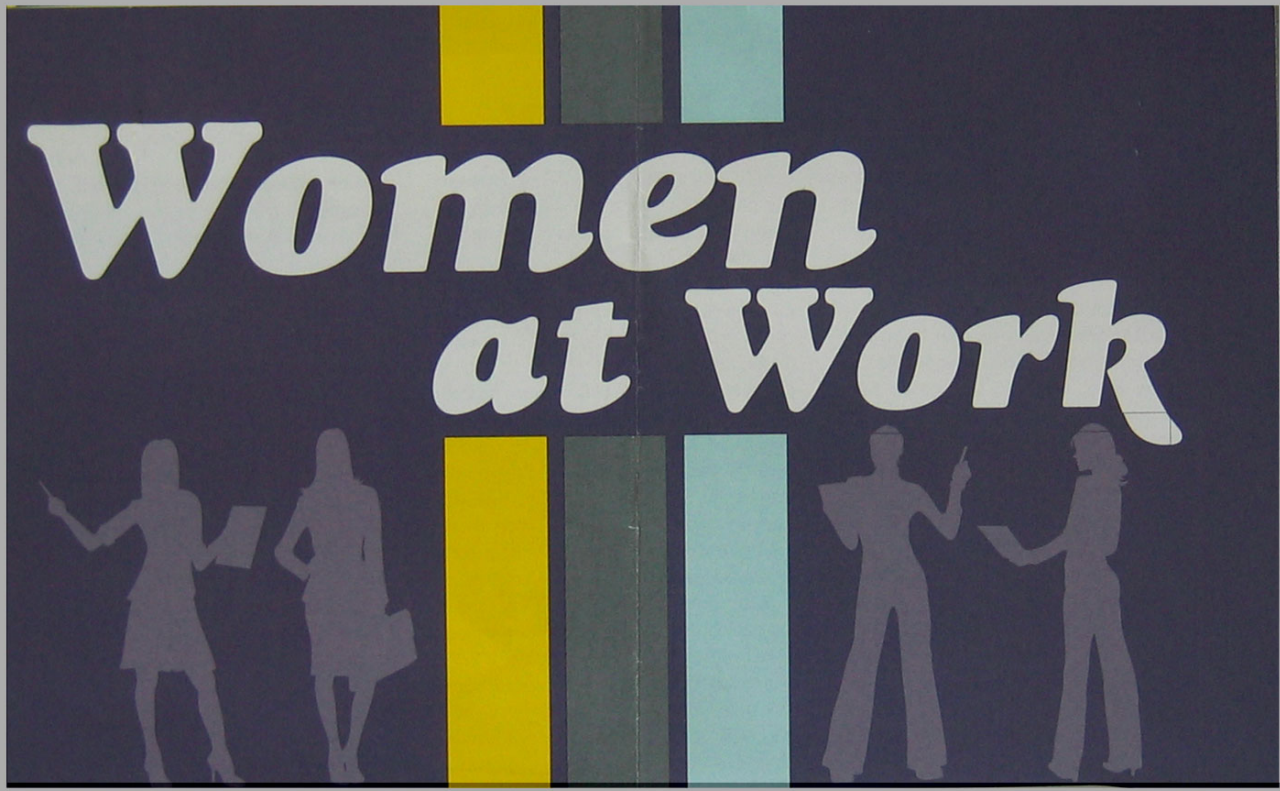

As a testament to her belief in community service, Davis has filled leadership roles in: Rotary, Better Business Bureau, Columbus Literacy Alliance, Columbus Chamber of Commerce, Columbus Partners in Education, Columbus Hospice, and her alma mater Columbus State University. She is a member of a dozen more organizations.

Helping TIC members achieve financial balance in their lives is Davis' professional goal. "It is important to me to help our team of world-class financial guides to achieve this mission," she explains.

She takes seriously her obligation to bring the national credit union movement to the Columbus area and serves as an ambassador for the credit union movement at the state, national and international levels. As such, she has served on the National Credit Union Foundation board and as president of the local credit union chapter. She also holds numerous leadership positions at the state level. In addition, she has been honored as the Credit Union Professional of the Year for the entire country.
