TIC CEO Janet Davis honored by association

Janet Davis, president and chief executive officer of Columbus-based TIC Federal Credit Union, has received a Lifetime Achievement Award from the state trade association.

Duluth, Ga.-based Georgia Credit Union Affiliates, an advocacy and support organization, said Monday that Davis and six others were honored at a convention Friday in Savannah, Ga.

The lifetime award, the association said, "is presented to one individual whose credit union career stands as an example for others to follow. Because the award is not given annually, when a recipient is selected, the honor is all the more revered."

Davis, 51, has been with TIC since 1983, holding several board positions at the state and national levels, while serving on a number of community organizations in the Columbus area. She has been president and CEO since 1991.

Davis has led the 54-year-old credit union through unprecedented growth. It has more than 40,000 members on both sides of the Chattahoochee River and is now the ninth-largest in Georgia with assets of \$200 million-plus..

"I am truly humbled by this honor," Davis said in a statement. "To be recognized by my peers for something that I feel so passionate about is very special to me. I am fortunate to work in a movement where 'people helping people' is more than just a slogan. It's a way of doing business."

Two other Columbus-area residents also were honored during the awards. Gail Chandler, CEO of Regional Members Federal Credit Union in Columbus, was named Professional of the Year.

Peggy Martin, a board member with Members United Credit Union in Columbus, was named Volunteer of the Year.

Georgia Credit Union Affiliates works with 163 credit unions in the state. Those financial institutions have a combined 1.8 million members and more than \$16 billion in assets.
