Credit union to provide tax help

Georgia Federal Credit Union has partnered with the Internal Revenue Service and the University of Georgia's College of Family and Consumer Sciences to provide the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program, making it convenient for income tax return filers to become new members of the credit union.

The VITA program extends tax return assistance to individuals and families with low to moderate income. Several VITA sites will be open beginning Tuesday through March 7 and GFCU representatives will be available to open savings and checking accounts remotely.
